A block of rooms is reserved under Haliburton Real Easy Ryders and will be held until **May 25th, 2026**. Members wishing to participate in this trip can make their reservation directly with Benmiller Inn. Please be aware that the Inn has a limited number of rooms with two separate beds. When making your reservation, please book the room type that best matches your actual sleeping needs. Please inform Don Critchley after booking your accommodation (check your club email for his contact info) and let him know the number of people booked, who is riding and who is not. A participation list will be generated knowing that slight alterations may occur.

Please let the front desk know (at time of room booking) if you would like breakfast. If 50 people + would like this option, it will be served as a buffet breakfast with eggs, bacon, sausage, french toast, bread, preserves, fruit tray, scones, coffee/tea, juice. Price \$22.00 + tax which will be added to your room bill and settled by each at check out.

If cancellation is necessary, a full reimbursement will be given until **May 29th, 2026**. No refund will be provided after said date.

Bikes are **not** allowed in the rooms. There is a shed across from The Woolen Inn that can accommodate 20 bikes. One key is available at the front desk OR The Maitland Room which is located in Gledhill House and locked/opened by Night Audit staff.
